



Did you figure out the Bible names by rearranging the letters and then find which books of the Bible they appear in or wrote?


1. Jaileh – **Elijah**’s life is largely to be found in 1 Kings and by 2 Kings 2 he is taken up into heaven
2. Henteps – **Stephen** is the first martyr and we read his story in Acts chapter 7 when he is stoned to death
3. Ulpa – Paul – St **Paul** as Saul was present at Stephen’s death but after his conversion wrote many of the Epistles in the New Testament – although not all those bearing his name are now thought to be written by him.
4. Bamhara – **Abraham**’s story is in Genesis he is called by God in chapter 12 and dies in chapter 25
5. Lisas – **Silas** – is the companion of Paul – we find him first in Acts 15.22 but then he is mentioned as co-author of the two letters to the Thessalonians and also appears in 2 Corinthians 1:19 and 1 Peter as a ‘faithful brother’
6. Anho – **Noah** – his adventures are recorded in Genesis 5-9
7. Raash – **Sarah** – as Abraham’s wife she also appears in Genesis but was originally called Sarai - Gen 17.15 tells of her change of name by God
8. Nana – **Anna** – the old woman who identified the baby Jesus in the Temple in Luke’s gospel – 2.36 - 40
9. Ossem – **Moses**’ – birth is recorded in Exodus and he dies at the end of Deuteronomy
10. Utist - **Titus** – was the recipient of an epistle nominally from Paul and he also appears in Galatians 2.3


