

The intention is to return before Easter, hopefully Palm Sunday, subject to any change in circumstances — more details next week. We acknowledged that we are all, as a nation and individually, now in a phase of recovery which may last many months and which will present challenges. One hallmark of this is the need to accept change and to remain flexible. The PCC felt that this time could be one of rich opportunity where we are open to trying new patterns of services to accommodate both those attending in person and those still choosing to stay safe at home.

Please bear with us during these next few months so we can find the service pattern which allows the maximum number of people to take part and move towards a fixed pattern later in the year, once things are a little clearer. We hope to continue to live stream services whatever.
