Some of the shapes in the church building include circles, arches, cylinders, diamonds, flowers, triangles, rectangles and squares

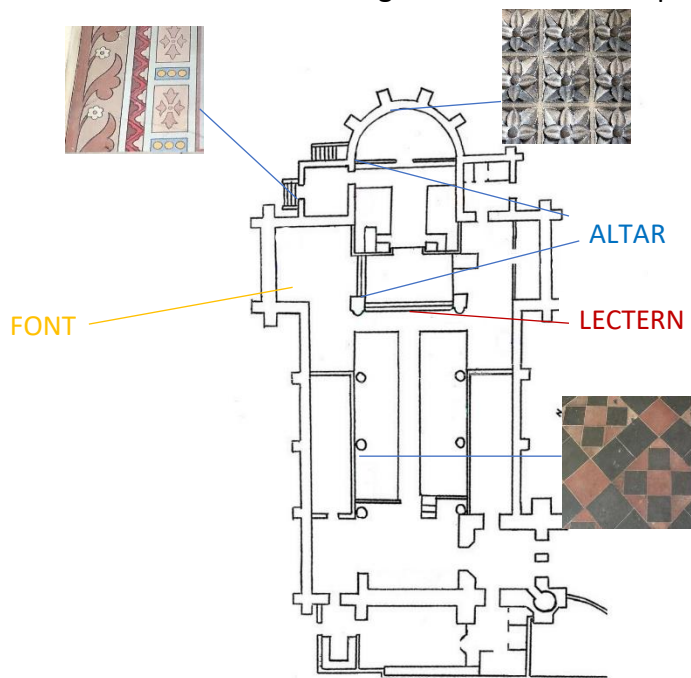
There are 44 pews (the choir stalls are not strictly pews!)

## 7. Objects and Symbols

**Lectern** – a lectern is a tall stand with a sloping top to hold a book or notes, from which someone, typically a preacher or lecturer, can read while standing up

**Altar** – an altar is the table in a Christian church at which the bread and wine are blessed in communion services

**Font** – a font is a receptacle in a church for the water used in baptism

Their locations are marked on the map above

## 8. Outside

Types of trees in the churchyard include:

olive, yew, oak, cedar, cherry

The inscription is on the wall of the East end of the church. The name of the person who built the church is **William Matthew Coulthurst**, and he built it in memory of his sister, who was called **Hannah Mabella Coulthurst**.
