"Some years Christmas can be a bit overwhelming. Perhaps we have been dealing with death or illness. Perhaps we are feeling depressed or are concerned about other people or things going on in the world. No matter what is making the glitter seem less sparkly than usual, you are welcome to attend Blue Christmas. This service will still talk about the Christmas story, but in a quieter way. It will give you space to allow yourself to be who you are and how you are feeling. Tears are OK at Christmas. We often feel we have to be brave for others, and sometimes we do, but it is exhausting. Join us, take a break from the hustle and bustle, listen to the ancient story and allow it to be what it is this year for you."
